The Norwegian Consortium for Microbial Genomics (NCMG) is a national network bringing together scientists with complementary expertise to exchange knowledge about transmission of infectious diseases and antimicrobial resistance. NCMG was established in 2016 to stimulate the development of Next Generation Sequencing for microbiology in a One Health perspective in Norway.

Previous meetings of the consortium were held in May 2016, December 2017, December 2019, February 2021, December 2021, and December 2022, and have assembled each about 100 participants.

We are planning a hybrid format, with attendance and speakers could either meet at NIPH or join online.

The meeting will combine talks from international speakers and presentations of ongoing Norwegian projects.
