

Request for Access to Your Personal Health Data

The Norwegian Public Health Survey

This form is used to request access to your personal health data linked to your name or national ID number in the Norwegian Public Health Survey. It is important that all fields in the form are completed correctly. We cannot process your access request if the form is incomplete or contains incorrect information.

I hereby request access to the health data registered about me in the Norwegian Public Health Survey (cf. Health Register Act § 24 and GDPR Article 15).

Valid identification

You must remember to include a copy of valid identification when submitting this form. This is because we need confirmation of your identity in order to process your access request.

What is a valid ID?

The identification must not be expired and must include a photo, name, signature, and either a national ID number or D-number.

If you do not have a Norwegian national ID number or D-number, the identification must include your date of birth, place of birth, and gender, in addition to a photo, name, and signature.

Please note: The newest passports no longer display the national ID number on the same page as before. You must therefore include images of both the **main passport page** and the **page showing your national ID number**.

What is accepted as identification?

- Passport (not emergency passport)
- Norwegian bank card with photo
- Norwegian driving licence – original and duplicate (not an older driving licence – "green driving licence")
- Nordic driving licences of EU/EEA standard
- Posten's ID cards issued after 1 October 1994
- National ID card issued within the EEA
- Norwegian immigrant's passport
